YOU HAVE 2 REPORTING OPTIONS:

Restricted Report

A confidential report of sexual assault that allows victims to receive support and services, but does NOT inform command or initiate an investigation.

Unrestricted Report

A report of sexual assault that allows victims to receive support and services and initiates an investigation.

Command notification is made.

SAPR Definitions:

Sexual Assault: Intentional sexual contact by force, threats, intimidation, abuse of authority, or victim does not or cannot consent

Consent: Freely given agreement to the conduct at issue by a competent person

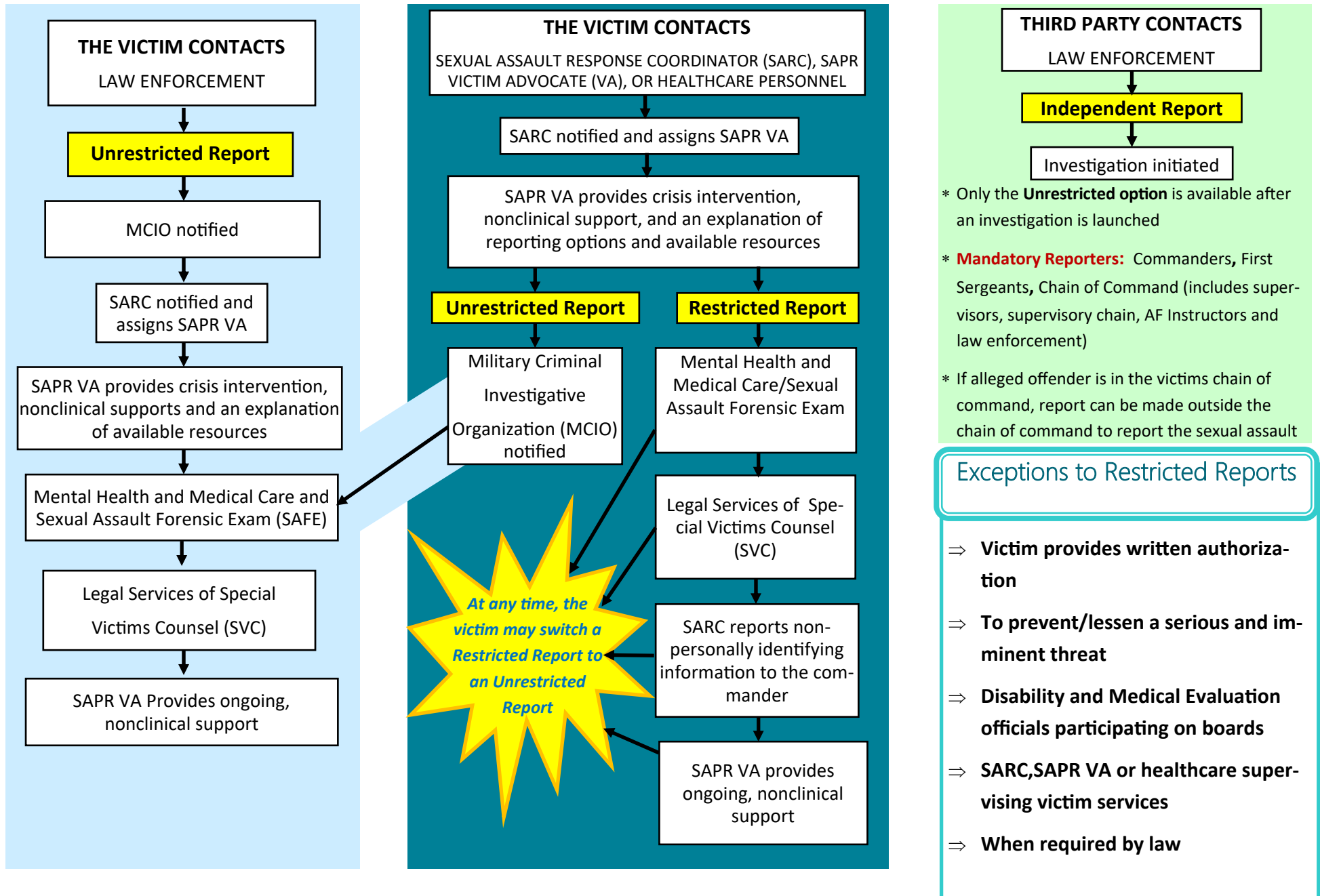
