# YOU HAVE 2 REPORTING OPTIONS:

## Restricted Report

A confidential report of sexual assault that allows victims to receive support and services, but does NOT inform command or initiate an investigation.

#### **Unrestricted Report**

A report of sexual assault that allows victims to receive support and services and initiates an investigation.

Command notification is made.

### **SAPR Definitions:**

Sexual Assault: Intentional sexual contact by force, threats, intimidation, abuse of authority, or victim does not or cannot consent

Consent: Freely given agreement to the conduct at issue by a competent person



# **Sexual Assault Response Report Flow Chart**





- \* Only the **Unrestricted option** is available after an investigation is launched
- Mandatory Reporters: Commanders, First Sergeants, Chain of Command (includes supervisors, supervisory chain, AF Instructors and law enforcement)
- If alleged offender is in the victims chain of command, report can be made outside the chain of command to report the sexual assault

## **Exceptions to Restricted Reports**

- ⇒ Victim provides written authorization
- ⇒ To prevent/lessen a serious and imminent threat
- ⇒ Disability and Medical Evaluation officials participating on boards
- ⇒ SARC,SAPR VA or healthcare supervising victim services
- ⇒ When required by law
