Chief Master Sergeant Stanley E. Drozdowski is the Command Chief Master Sergeant for the 134th Air Refueling Wing, McGhee Tyson Air National Guard Base, Tennessee. He is the primary advisor to the Wing Commander and is the focal point for all activities affecting the enlisted force, to include operations, readiness, training, utilization, morale, technical and professional development, and overall quality of life for over 1000 enlisted members in the organization

CMSgt Drozdowski entered the Air Force in July 1996 as a Security Forces journeyman. He graduated from Security Police and Air Base Ground Defense course at Lackland Air Force Base, Texas, in December 1996. His background includes various duties in security forces, civilian law enforcement, and as a First Sergeant.

First Sergeant Drozdowski has served 9 years on active duty in the Air Force in security forces, 10 years civilian law enforcement and 9 years in the Tennessee ANG in Security Forces and as a First Sergeant. Previous assignments include Incirlik AB, Turkey, Wright-Patterson AFB, OH, and McGhee Tyson ANGB, TN. During CMSgt Drozdowski career he deployed to Jordan, Uzbekistan, and Iraq in support of Operations Iraqi Freedom and Enduring Freedom. He also deployed to an undisclosed location in Southwest Asia in support of Operations Inherent Resolve/Freedoms Sentinel, and CJTF- Horn OF Africa. Chief Drozdowski worked as an intelligence analyst with the Tennessee Army National Guard Counter Drug program providing up to date information to assist in the arrest of drug traffickers.

He is currently a Security Police Officer II with the Department of Energy providing protection for special materials and weapons.
