COLONEL THOMAS S. CAUTHEN

Colonel Thomas S. Cauthen is the Wing Commander, 134th Air Refueling Wing Tennessee Air National Guard. He is responsible for the execution of all unit programs, and provides a focus for all unit functions and activities affecting over 1,800 Guard members and civilians. Colonel Cauthen ensures flying hour/sortie programs meet requirements, and the unit achieves mission training and combat readiness objectives. He is also responsible for mission capable KC-135R aircraft to meet all unit flying programs and alert/contingency requirements

Colonel Cauthen commissioned in 1984 through the Air National Guard Academy of Military Science. He has flown combat support aerial refueling missions for Desert Shield, Southern Watch, Joint Forge, Allied Force, Operation Enduring Freedom, Operation Noble Eagle, and Operation Iraqi Freedom. Additionally, Colonel Cauthen has deployed to Incirlik, Turkey as the 385th Air Expeditionary Forces



Operations Officer supporting Operation Enduring Freedom, to Istres, France as the Operations Officer for Joint Forge, and to Mildenhall, England as the 171st Air Expeditionary Wing Operations Group Commander supporting Operation Iraqi Freedom. From August to Nov 2000, Colonel Cauthen was an initial cadre Instructor Pilot for the 134th Air Refueling Wing conversion to Pacer Crag (Block 30).

Colonel Cauthen served in a variety of positions within the 134th. He was the Operations Support Flight Commander before becoming the 151st Air Refueling Squadron Commander in June 2001. In October 2003, Colonel Cauthen moved to Maintenance as the Maintenance Squadron Commander and was promoted to the Maintenance Group Commander in January 2004. Col Cauthen assumed the position of Vice Commander in August of 2006. In June 2011, Col Cauthen was selected as Wing Commander.
