It is the member's responsibility to visit the DEER's ID Card section with a copy of your orders to include all Amendments so that the DEER's representative can end your Active Duty Orders and flip the status to TA-180 to allow you the 180 days of TriCare benefits authorized.  PRDA- Personnel Records Display: This is your electronic record available to you via the AF portal. This is where you can find documents such as DD 214, Enlistment documents, Special Orders, SGLI contracts, etc. These are the source documents for your military career, please go out to the portal and take a look. ## AF Officials Release Video Tutorials to Educate Airmen about AFPERS

Air Force officials have created four video tutorials, or vodcasts, to educate personnel of the capabilities and features available on the Air Force Personnel Services, or AFPERS, website.

A team of Air Force personnelists and contractors collaborated on the vodcasts to teach Regular Air Force, Guard, Reserve and civilians Airmen about the basic functions of AFPERS, where to access it, how to create an account and what to do if a user ID or password is forgotten.

"We are using video tutorials as a way to provide awareness and information to our members on personnel services," said Mary McAfee, Air National Guard's personnel services delivery strategy chief. "These products will help ensure our Airmen are aware of the AFPERS website because it is our total force source for personnel information and services."

Future video tutorials being proposed include educating Airmen about the AFPERS civilian homepage, addressing the top five issues received by the Total Force Service Center and how the website can help answer other frequently asked questions or inquiries about personnel processes.
